OUR SCHOOL

At Westminster Christian Academy, our vision is to educate and disciple students, in partnership with Christian families, for lifelong learning and service in God's world. As a covenantal Christian school, all of our employees are Christians, and we require that at least one parent from every family be a professing follower of Jesus Christ, have a church home and pastoral relationship, and support the beliefs found in the Nicene Creed.

Our school is comprised of two campuses - the Lower Campus, which houses preschool for ages 3 and 4, our elementary school for Kindergarten through 5th grade,

and the Upper Campus, which houses our middle and high school. Our Upper Campus features the beautiful Van Dyke Athletic Complex, which is vibrant and still growing today. This campus is located near Research Park and is easily accessible from Huntsville or Madison.

Our Lower Campus is in the heart of Madison and includes a recent addition of eight classrooms, a tornado-safe area, and a competition gym with more space for family and community events.

ACADEMICS

Westminster provides a high-quality educational program that equips students with the skills and technology they need for success in whatever path they choose after graduation.

Our academic program includes dual enrollment and AP classes, fine arts, foreign language, integrated STEM opportunities in the classroom, flexible elective offerings, academic support, and academic and life-skills mentorship for every student through our Alliance and Advisory programs. Education today is exciting and relevant to their goals after high school.

Teachers use standards-based assessments to provide formative and summative testing. Data confirms that our teachers and curriculum, coupled with our safe and supportive environment, produce quality educational results, with student scores improving over past years' scores and rising above the national average.

We regularly have National Merit Scholars. Every year more than two-thirds of our seniors receive academic and athletic scholarships to major universities nationwide.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Westminster offers routine testing, tutoring, and academic support to help our students reach their full potential on their academic journey. For those students who encounter learning challenges, we have an academic support staff who works with the student, parents, and teachers to create a Student Learning Plan that includes academic support to meet a student's specific needs. Additional support for all students includes a variety of free tutoring options for math, reading, history, science, and executive functioning coaching during our FLEX period of the day.

Because we are a covenantal school for all students, not just the academically elite, we offer accommodations for students with a wide variety of learning differences.

A small-class pathway is available in some subjects for those who thrive with more individualized instruction. With a small student-to-teacher ratio, students can move at a slower pace and get the extra attention and support they need.

DISCIPLESHIP

At Westminster, we are committed to strong Christian discipleship, recognizing that each student's spiritual and emotional well-being is just as important as their academic growth. Our teachers, coaches, and staff are Christians who care deeply about their students and help them grow as followers of Jesus. Discipleship helps our students flourish in an environment of grace as they mature into adults and wise decision-makers. Upper Campus students enjoy mentoring Lower Campus students through Reading Buddies, Serve Day, and many more purposeful opportunities for connection.

CHAPEL

A chapel service is held every week for students and faculty at both campuses. This is a time set apart for worship that includes student-led music, prayer, and a message to help students grow in faith and character. Students who want to serve during chapel can lead worship through our Chapel Team.

ADVISORY GROUPS

Upper Campus students participate in Advisory groups, where a staff member and a small group of students meet to talk about what's going on in their lives and discuss important topics. This gives students adult advocates and role models in addition to their parents,

to encourage and help them navigate difficult situations.

SERVICE

Students can put their faith into action by serving others close to home and abroad. They can volunteer with local charities throughout the year including with organizations like the House of Harvest, Kids to Love, and the Downtown Rescue Mission.

LOWER CAMPUS

Westminster's Lower Campus is home to the preschool and elementary school, which provides an early start at age 3 and educates students through 5th grade. We have a caring community of teachers and families to partner with you in your child's education and faith development. During elementary school, students will develop a Christ-centered view of the world along with the academic skills needed for middle school.

Our curriculum includes reading, language development, the arts, math, science, social studies, technology, leadership development, and Bible lessons, which are applied across the curriculum.

Students stay engaged with plenty of hands-on activities and STEM opportunities, including computer applications and coding. They also have opportunities to participate in music, band, choir, and art. In addition to a strong foundation in core subjects, students are prepared emotionally and socially for the next step in their education.

Elementary students also need plenty of exercise and time for play. Our curriculum includes physical education and outdoor play so that students will develop healthy bodies, improve their social skills, and increase their attention spans.

UPPER CAMPUS

Westminster's Upper Campus is home to our middle school, for 6th through 8th grade, and our high school for 9th through 12th grade. Although they share one campus, middle school and high school classes are typically held on different floors.

During these formative years, we work to provide a high-quality education that equips students with the skills and knowledge they need to succeed after high school while becoming confident in the truth of God's word.

Our college preparatory curriculum includes a variety of choices including AP and dual-enrollment courses, foreign language choices, and electives in technology and the arts. We offer a FLEX period that allows our students to personalize a portion of

their day to participate in clubs, enrichment opportunities, or to spend time with teachers in a subject area where they need extra help.

With the help of our college and career advisor and school counselor, we help students take the right steps toward the future they desire. We currently use Naviance, a software tool that allows students to explore career options, colleges, and more. Westminster graduates are prepared for college, the military, missions, technical and service career fields.

A majority of our graduates consistently score higher than the national average on the ACT, securing college placement and scholarships to enhance their success.

BAND AND COLOR GUARD

The Westminster Christian Academy band program features the Spirit of Westminster Marching Band and Color Guard, High School Concert Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band, Special Ensemble Performance Band, Middle School Symphonic Band, 6th Grade Concert Band, and 5th Grade Beginner Concert Band.

These bands perform at various athletic events, home football games, pep rallies, and during fine arts chapel services. They also host concerts in the winter and spring. The marching band and color guard compete in yearly music festivals and continue to bring home superior ratings. The wind ensemble performs multiple times, yearly, for parents and staff and is also assessed by the state of Alabama at the Music Performance Assessment Festival.

CHOIR

We have an active and growing choral program with numerous performance opportunities throughout the year, such as singing in chapel at both the Lower and Upper Campuses. The choir hosts annual winter and spring concerts for the

Westminster community and competes in state and regional festivals.

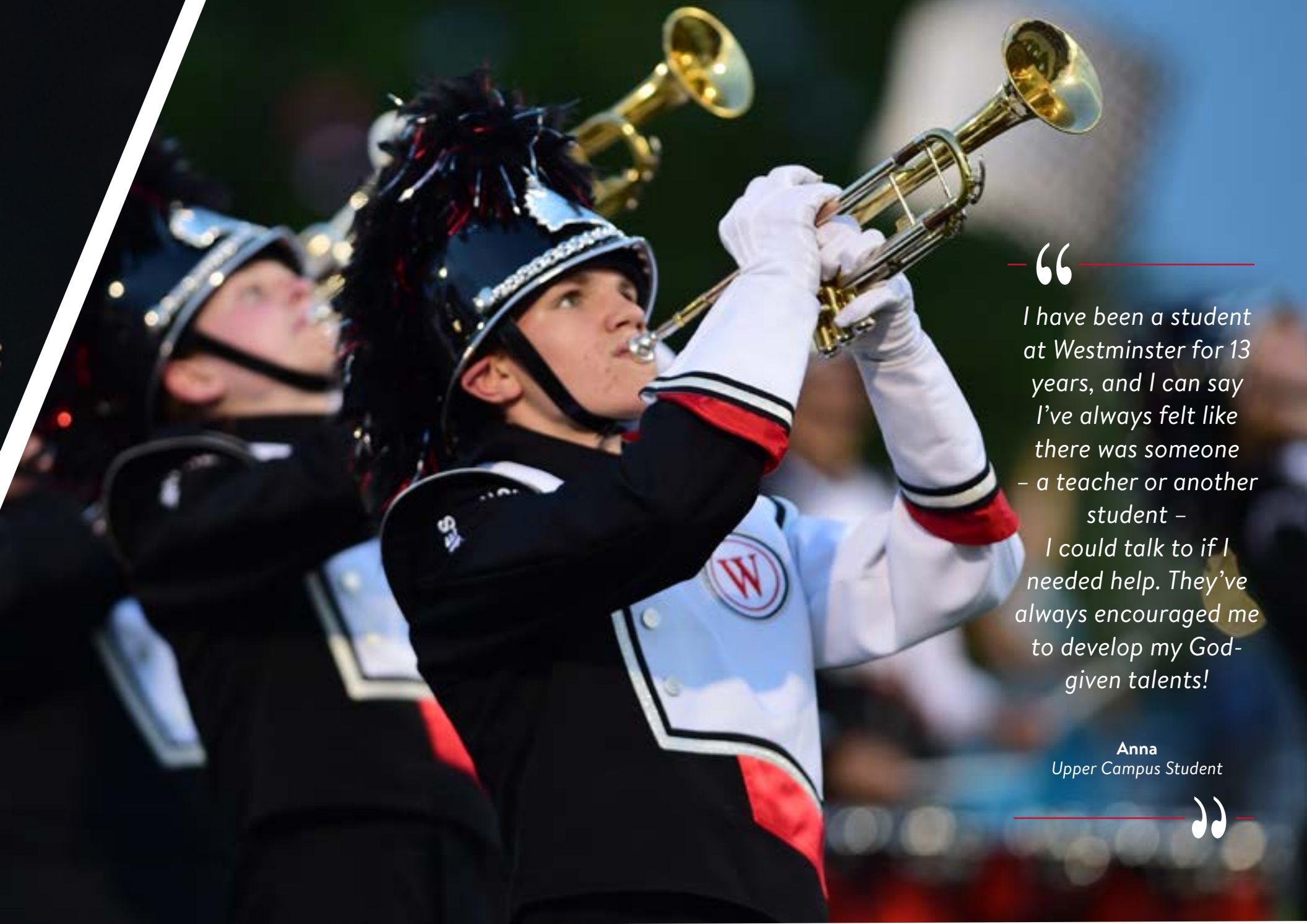
VISUAL ARTS & DIGITAL MEDIA

Westminster holds over 12 State Championships and more than 60 Individual and Relay titles. Westminster offers 17 unique sports, guided by coaches who mentor student-athletes in both competition and Christ-centered character.

With our thriving elementary sports program, including our pep squad, students begin learning team dynamics while having fun exploring their interests.

Westminster offers more than 48 different middle school, junior varsity, and varsity sports teams including

football, flag football, basketball, baseball, softball, volleyball, swimming, golf, tennis, track and field, E-sports, middle and high school cheer squad, high school dance team, and much more.
